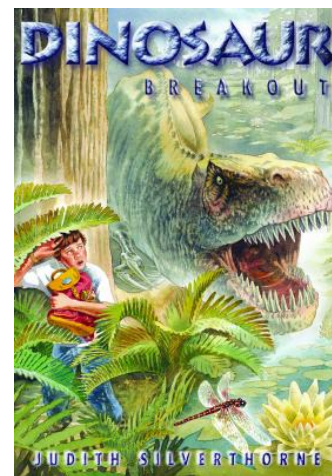


## Let's pop into the Library to read a good book



Nothing's better than building with boxes!  
Meg is a brilliant and creative boxitect. She loves building extraordinary things out of ordinary cardboard boxes and impressing her classmates with what she creates. But then a new kid comes to Maker School: Simone. Simone is good at everything. Worst of all, she's a boxitect too! Will Meg and Simone find a way to push past their rivalry and join creative forces?

In *Dinosaur Hideout*, Daniel and Pederson, a reclusive paleontologist living on a neighbouring farm in southwestern Saskatchewan, made a brilliant discovery--the fossil remains of an Edmontosaurus dinosaur. Now in this sequel, local bullies Todd and Craig Nelwin, jealous of all the attention Daniel gets, want to find his hideout and wreck it. When the three scuffle and Daniel hits his head, he mysteriously time travels into the world of Cretaceous dinosaurs - Triceratops, Brontosaurus, Tyrannosaurus Rex. When another strange shock brings him back to his own time, Daniel at first doesn't realize that he carries a small piece of the past. Whenever he touches it, he will return to the dinosaurs' world. Daniel makes two more unplanned but thrilling trips to the past. He sees the most marvellous, and horrifying, sights and makes new discoveries about dinosaurs. On a final trip, Daniel has two unwilling "hitchhikers" with him--the Nelwins. Daniel isn't the only one who learns from their sudden shared adventure.

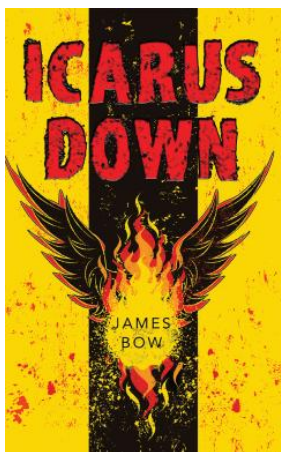


Three generations after the crash of the colony ship Icarus, Iapix is barely hanging on: one of thirteen cities suspended halfway down deep chasms. The sun on the diamond lands above will kill a man in less than five minutes. The ticktock monsters in the fog forest below are a little slower - but quite a bit smarter. But on his final test flight, something goes wrong. Isaac is killed. Simon is burned; his body will never be the same.

Neither will his world. Not everything in Iapix is quite as it seems, and through his rehabilitation Simon falls into the middle of a conspiracy that will bring everything he's ever known to the ground. Down in the fog forest, monsters await - but so does the truth . . . if Simon can survive long enough to find it.

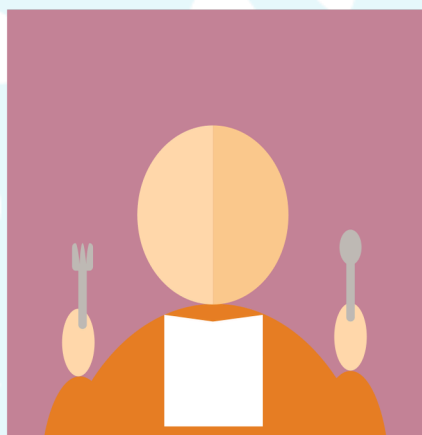

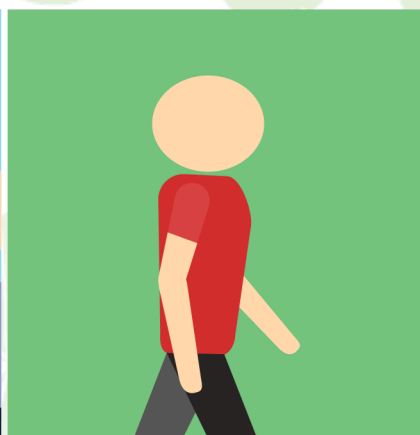
## MINDFULNESS THROUGHOUT YOUR DAY



**Be mindful while you're eating** - Pay attention to what you're eating and all of the senses involved while eating a meal.



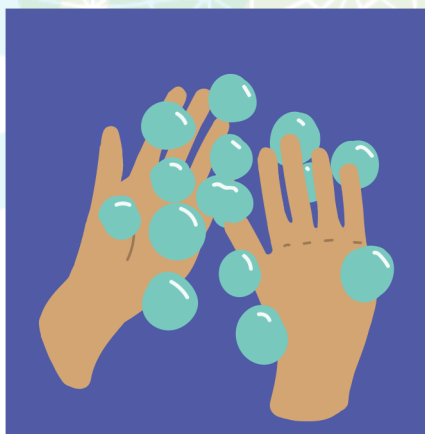
**Stay present while you're waiting** - When waiting for the bus, an appointment, or a friend, focus your attention on the present moment.



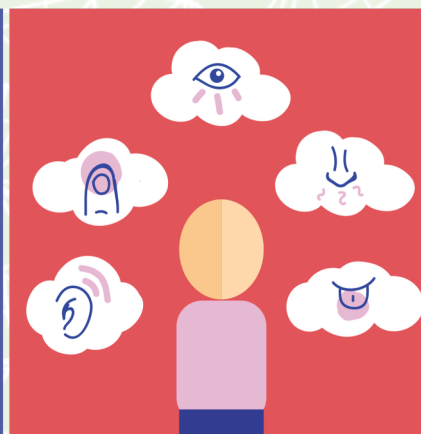
**Notice your surroundings while walking** - Try walking without distractions like your music or your phone. Try to notice something new on a familiar route



**Feel your feet on the ground** - Focus your attention on the soles of your feet. Feel them against the ground and notice everything you can about them.



**Pay attention while you're washing your hands** - Focus on the temperature of the water, the feeling of the water and soap on your hands and the movements your hands make.



**Notice something different when looking at familiar objects** - Try using all of your senses to explore a familiar object in a different way.
